Martine De Serres is Assistant General Counsel, Customer Regulator and Resolution at Air Canada. She heads the legal department's Customer Regulatory and Resolution team, which is responsible for handing passenger litigation and for providing legal advice on consumer law, including on passenger rights, accessibility, and advertising.
