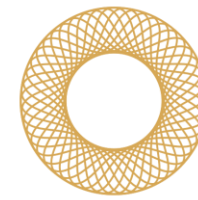

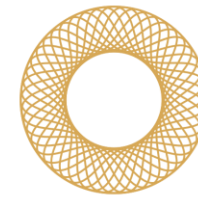




# Armed Forces

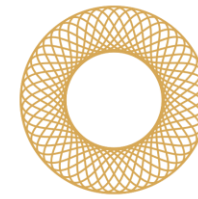
- Army

# Compensation claims

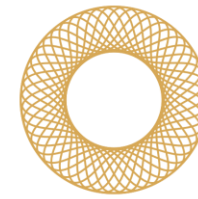
- 3,414 – 6,897 per year between 2018/19 and 2022/23
- Vast majority – service related noise-induced hearing loss (around 4,571 in 2022/23)
- Also – asbestos related, clinical negligence, motor
- Total expenditure – 2022/23 – £160 million

- Died on 6 February 2019 at Sandhurst Military Academy

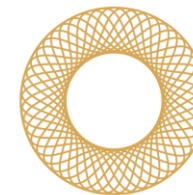




# Defence Sub-Committee Report 2021

- 62% of female Service personnel and veterans who responded to survey experienced bullying, harassment and discrimination
- 21% of servicewomen who responded to survey had either experienced or witnessed sexual harassment at work in the previous 12 months
